Requirement

Operational Requirements Document (ORD) for the individual Combat Clothing and Equipment (ICCE) CDTS# 93295DP

Overview

The U.S. Marine Corps requires a Waterproofing Bag liner (WPI) for the Individual Load Bearing Equipment (ILBE) Main Pack, and a smaller one for the ILBE Assault Pack. The purpose of the WPI is to keep clothing and equipment dry when the pack is exposed to prolonged rain or water submersion during field use. These items will be SL-3 components of the ILBE.

Features

Main Pack WPI

- Olive green exterior and interior
- 0.80 lbs.
- Waterproof 3,600 cubic inch (volume of main pack to spindrift collar)

Assault Pack WPI

- Olive green exterior with a fluorescent orange interior, with the top three inches of the bag solid green to minimize visual signature
- 0.85 lbs.
- Waterproof 1,500 cubic inches (volume of Assault Pack)
