### Overview

The Corpsman Assault Pack (CAP) is an improved design to replace the previously fielded Modular Lightweight Load Bearing Equipment (MOLLE) system. The CAP program is part of the Family of Field Medical Equipment, PM-CBRN Systems.

### Features

- Compartmentalization for medical instruments and equipment
- Improved ergonomics
- Reduced bulk through compression straps
- Removable inserts for enhanced, customized mission configurations
- Complete integration with Family of ILBE items, to include hydration system

Other ILBE systems include: Reconnaissance ILBE and the Standard ILBE.
