USMC Light Duty Glove Insert



Requirement

Product improvement.

Overview

The Light Duty Glove Insert is a product improvement replacing the "Improved Glove Insert", PGC 02586. The intent is to eliminate the melt/drip hazard, which could occur with the old polyester/lycra insert, by changing to a cotton/lycra insert.

Features

The glove insert is a four finger and thumb design designed to be worn either alone or under a glove shell. It is made from a water repellant treated knitted cotton/lycra blend with grip dots covering the fingers and palm.

The glove insert will be sustained through DSCP.

Production

Small Buy: DSCP awarded a small purchase to Mitts Nitts on August 11, 2008 for a quantity of 40,000 units with deliveries scheduled to begin in Dec 08 with a completion date of March 09. This buy only incorporates the change to cotton/lycra, and does not reference the new PD or incorporate the new sizing.

Large Buy: As of September 2008, DSCP could not proceed with the large acquisition. DSCP is waiting on approval from their technicians to go forward with the buy. This buy will be done using the new Purchase Description (CR/PD 02-2008 SYSCOM, dated 18 August, 2008) which will incorporate all design and material changes, as well as the new sizing.
